Camp United We Stand (CUWS)

Camp United We Stand is a smaller self-managed camp of no more than 35 which was established in late 2014. So far, **CUWS** has been hosted exclusively in North Seattle and Shoreline. With Greater Seattle Cares' assistance, this camp has also formed a non-profit organization with its own board of directors to provide legal organization to the camp. Residents at **Camp United We Stand** contribute \$30 per month towards the cost of running the camp. **CUWS** is 100% drug and alcohol free.

CUWS moves to a new location every 3 months. Currently, the Camp is residing at a property near-by and owned by Richmond Beach Congregational Church. The Camp already has its next location secured. The weekend of November 18, 2017, the Camp is moving to the Saint Dunstan's Episcopal Church of Shoreline. The physical location is on 145th between Aurora Ave North and Greenwood Ave N.
